JUDGMENT

The petitioner approached the first respondent alleging that the fourth respondent fraudulently obtained a registration certificate to run a poultry shop owned by the respondent Panchayath. According to the petitioner, this was originally obtained by the petitioner's husband and on his death, the fourth respondent fraudulently obtained registration from the first respondent. Therefore, this has to be cancelled.

This Court is of the view, the first respondent shall take a decision in the matter after hearing the petitioner and officials of the first respondent as well as the fourth respondent within one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment. It is also open for the Panchayath to take appropriate action for cancelling D & O licence.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
