**JUDGMENT**

The petitioner, who is the manager of the school, has appointed the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> respondents as teachers of the school. In the writ petition, the petitioner is aggrieved by the delay occasioned by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in taking a decision with regard to approval of Exts.P1, P1(a), P1(b), and P1(c) appointment orders, issued in favour of respondents 3 to 6. It is therefore, that the writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to take an expeditious decision in respect of approval of Exts.P1 to P1 (c) appointment orders.

2. I have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as also the learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

On a consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case as also the submissions made across the bar, I dispose the writ petition with a direction to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to take a decision with regard to the approval of respondents 3 to 6 pursuant to Exts.P1, P1(a), P1(b), and P1(c) appointment orders, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this

judgment, after hearing the petitioner and respondents 3 to 6. The petitioner shall produce a copy of the writ petition together with a copy of this judgment before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent for further action.
