JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection in the matter relating to loading and unloading work to be carried on by the petitioner in his own premises.

2. An interim order had been passed by this Court permitting the petitioner to carry on the loading and unloading work through his registered workers who are having identity cards under Rule 26(A) of the Headload Workers Rules.

3. Counter affidavit has been filed by the 2nd respondent Union stating that they have registered members in the Union and are entitled to demand the work.

4. But fact remains that the petitioner's workers are already having identity cards and he is entitled to carry on the loading and unloading work through his own registered workers.

We dispose of the Writ Petition making the interim order absolute.
