JUDGMENT

The petitioner alleging harassment at the instance of the party respondents have raised various complaints before different authorities, including the Kerala Women's Commission.

2. The petitioner approached this Court alleging that in spite of interference by the Women's Commission, no action has been taken by the Police Officials. Therefore, the petitioner approached the Police Chief of the State by Ext.P10. The petitioner seeks a disposal of Ext.P10 by Police Chief of the State.

3. This Court is of the view that since the petitioner has already approached Women's Commission, they may conduct such an enquiry and take suitable measures on the petitioner's grievances. Therefore, there shall be a

direction to the Kerala Women's Commission to take appropriate action on petitioner's complaint and to see that the petitioner's grievances are redressed. Needful shall be done within a period of three months.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
