J U D G M E N T

The petitioner contends that the demand evidenced by Ext.P2 letter is not in tune with the Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014. It is also stated that the same militates against the orders passed by the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission.

2. Similar writ petitions have been disposed of relegating the parties to the Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum. A complaint can be filed therefore under Regulation 130(8) of the Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014. Any motion made in that regard within three weeks from today shall be dealt with appropriately.

3. The petitioner is however granted liberty to pay the amount demanded under protest. The amount can be paid in three fortnightly instalments starting from 15.9.2015.

The writ Petition is disposed of.
