Petitioner has approached this Court seeking police protection apprehending that private respondents may come and conduct agitation at their residence. Perusal of Ext.P9 complaint given to the police indicates that petitioner has only expressed an apprehension and no incident has occurred.

2. Having regard to the aforesaid factual situation, we do not think that any direction, as sought for in this writ petition, is required to be passed. We only observe that if any such incident as apprehended by the petitioner occurs, it shall always be open for the petitioner to approach the local police, who shall look into the matter and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

This writ petition is disposed of as above.
