J U D G M E N T

The petitioners in W.P.(C) No.26151 of 2015 are the students undergoing Paramedical Courses of Diploma in Dialysis Technology (DDT) and Diploma in Ophthalmic Assistance (DOA), from the year 2013-14. The petitioners in W.P.(C) No.26150 of 2015 are the students of that college undergoing the same course from the year 2012-2013.

2. They approached this Court on account of delay in publishing their examination results. It appears that they have appeared for the examination in the year November 2014.

3. It is contended by the learned Government Pleader that that the management is conducting this course without any valid recognition and also without providing any facilities to the students. It is also submitted that the petitioners have appeared for the examination based on the Government order.

4. This Court is of the view that the petitioners only sought

for relief of publication of results, leaving open all other issues, the result of the petitioners shall be published. However the official respondents are free to take appropriate action against the management in accordance with the law.

The writ petition is disposed of, as above.
