J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is the owner of a stage carriage bearing registration No.KL-13 K 1095. He had applied for a regular permit on the route Thrikkadipoli-Kuthuparamba-Panniyode. The grievance of the petitioner in the writ petition is that although the petitioner had preferred an application for grant of temporary permit, the same has not been considered by the respondent.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as also the learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondent.
