JUDGMENT

The petitioner confines her relief to an early consideration of Ext.P6 application for re-issue of temporary permit. The additional second respondent points out that the directions in Ext. R2(b) judgment have to be complied with before Ext. P6 application is considered.

2. I direct the first respondent to consider Ext. P6 application with notice to the petitioner as well as the additional second respondent. The implications of Ext. R2(b) judgment shall also be adverted to in the exercise.

3. The petitioner is permitted to operate service till orders are passed on Ext. P6 application. Every endeavour shall be made to pass orders on Ext. P6 application within a period of two weeks.
