J U D G M E N T

The petitioner, aggrieved by the delay in the matter of renewal of Arms licence, has approached this court.

2. This matter is pending before the 2nd respondent-District Collector, Thrissur, which was remitted to the 2nd respondent based on a remand order passed by the Land Revenue Commissioner. It appears that the District Collector sought the views of Forest officials. The petitioner submits that favourable orders have now been issued by the Forest officials.
