Ext.P1 appeal has been filed by the petitioners under Rule 6(10) of the Kerala Panchayat Raj (Burial & Burning Grounds) Rules, 1998. The said appeal has been preferred with the first respondent against Ext.P2 order of the second respondent granting licence to set up a public crematorium.

2. It is open to the petitioners to apply for appropriate interim orders in Ext.P1 appeal pending with the first respondent. Any motion made in that regard shall be dealt with within a period of one months of its preferment.

3. Every endeavour shall be made to dispose of Ext.P1 appeal also expeditiously. The same shall be done within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
