JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, C.J.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging police harassment. Petitioner's case is that with regard to a scuffle occurred on 28.08.2015 with one Sujith, police party attached to the 1st respondent are visiting the petitioner's house. He submits that he has applied for Anticipatory Bail but it was reported that no crime has been registered.

2. Learned Government Pleader after obtaining instructions would submit that neither any crime has been registered nor police parties have visited the petitioner's house.

In view of the aforesaid statement, we do not find any police harassment in this case. Recording the aforesaid statement of learned Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is closed.
