J U D G M E N T

Petitioner raised a complaint against the fifth respondent for illegally extracting soil from the land situated in Re-Survey No.200/6 in Block No.14 of Uliyazhithura Village. Based on the complaint, a stop memo was issued by the Village Officer. Petitioner submits that in spite of stop memo, the fifth respondent is continuing with illegal activities.

2. If the stop memo has not been interdicted by the competent authority so far, appropriate steps shall be taken by the second respondent, if necessary with the assistance of the fourth respondent to stop the activities of the fifth respondent. If a request is made, the fourth respondent shall also render necessary assistance to the petitioner.

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This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction.
