2. It is submitted that the petitioner was given short term permit based on the application.

In view of the above, if the petitioner moves an application before the Village (Dweep) Panchayath (second respondent), that application shall be considered in accordance with law. The petitioner can conduct slaughtering house in future only after obtaining orders from the Panchayath. The petitioner cannot operate slaughtering house without obtaining permission. The Panchayath shall consider the application within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
