JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, Ag.CJ.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader as well as the counsel appearing for party respondents.

2. This Writ Petition has been filed by an Educational Institution which is running Business Management College approved by AICTE. Petitioner's case is that respondent Nos. 2 to 12 who claim to be union leaders have obstructed the functioning of the institution. A direction has been sought in the Writ Petition to respondents 1 to 3 to afford adequate and effective

police protection in the running of the Institution as well as the ingress and egress of the teachers, staff and students of the College without any obstruction or interference from respondents 4 to 12. This Court has already issued an interim order on 5th November, 2014.

2. The learned Government Pleader submits that in view of the interim order adequate protection has been provided and as on date there is no obstruction from respondent Nos. 4 to 12. Accordingly, recording the aforesaid submission, we dispose of this Writ Petition. However, respondent No. 1 to 3 shall ensure that no obstruction is created by private respondents 4 to 12 in running of the institution as well as the ingress and egress of the teachers, staff and students of the Institution.
