JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J

Petitioners have approached this Court seeking for police protection inter alia contending that respondents 3 to 5 Unions are unnecessarily causing obstruction to the functioning of the college. In fact, the petitioners have approached earlier before this court by filing W.P(C) No.18101 of 2013 and by judgment dated 5.8.2013 this Court had directed respondents 1 and 2 to ensure that appropriate police protection is afforded to the petitioners for the smooth functioning of the college.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though on certain occasions, complaints have been filed, no action is taken to give protection.

3. Learned Government Pleader submits that on every opportunity when there is a complaint, the police has gone there and provided adequate protection and submits that the judgment in W.P(C) No.18101 of 2013 still holds good as far as the direction issued to respondents is concerned.

We take on record the above submission. The writ petition is closed.
