JUDGMENT

The petitioner availed cash credit facility from the respondent Bank. This account has been now classified by the Bank as NPA.

2. The petitioner submits that he is running a business and the Bank may be directed to regularise the loan account. He also seeks easy instalment facility and also for one time settlement of the liability. In this regard, he has approached the Bank with Ext.P4.

This Court is of the view, Ext.P4 shall be considered by the second respondent after hearing the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment. Till a decision is taken, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.
