“9. In such circumstance, there shall also be a direction to the 4th respondent to expedite the exercise under Section 33 of the Act of 1995 and identify the posts, at any rate within a period of three months from today. The 1st respondent Board shall produce a certified copy of the judgment before the 4th respondent and the 4th respondent shall act in accordance with the directions herein above within the period specified.
