JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader.

2. The petitioner has come up with the writ petition seeking police protection. Petitioner's case is that he has been awarded a contract by the Minor Irrigation Department. According to him, an agreement was executed on 19.09.2013. Petitioner's case is that obstruction is being created by private respondents in carrying out the contract.

3. We are of the view that in the facts of the present case, the course open for the petitioner is to bring it into notice of the Department, which has granted the contract and the Department has to take appropriate action by informing the police.

With the above observation the Writ Petition is closed.
