JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader. No notice is being issued to respondent Nos.3 and 4 in view of the order which is being passed.

2. The 3rd respondent is the cousin of petitioner's wife and 4th respondent is said to be a close associate of 3rd respondent. Petitioner's case is that the petitioner was attacked by 3rd and 4th respondents and he was hit by them. The petitioner has filed Ext.P4 complaint dated 27.09.2015, which according to learned Government Pleader, has not been received so far. If so advised, the petitioner can file appropriate complaint before the 2nd respondent who may look into the same and do the needful in accordance with law.

With the above observation, the Writ Petition is closed.
