JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection due to the obstruction being caused by respondents 2 and 3 in the matter relating to loading and unloading work carried on by the petitioner in his business premises. It is not in dispute that the area in question is a scheme covered area. The petitioner had already applied for registration card for his workers.

2. It submitted by learned counsel appearing for respondents 2 and 3 that so far as the petitioner was unable to obtain the registration card as the matter is pending consideration before the 4th respondent.

The fact being so we do not think that the prayer as sought for can be granted. Hence we close the
