The petitioner has approached this Court seeking for police protection alleging that respondents 4 to 6 have taken steps to remove the bunk, in which the petitioner is carrying on the business of selling of lottery tickets. It is submitted by the petitioner that the bunk has already been removed.

2. Under such circumstances, we do not think that any direction can be given to the police for rendering police protection from unlawfully evicting or preventing the petitioner from carrying on his business in the present spot.

In the result, there being no merit in the contentions raised in the writ petition. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
