JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader. No notice is being issued to the private respondents in view of the order which is being passed.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking police protection. Petitioner's case is that on a complaint dated 28.09.2015 the Child Welfare Committee has registered a case. Allegations have been made against the private respondents, who according to the petitioner, have attacked the petitioner even causing injuries.

3. Learned Government Pleader after obtaining instructions submits that on a report being submitted by the Police to the Child Welfare Committee, the complaint has been closed. It is further submitted that several complaints have been filed by the petitioner as well as by the residents against the petitioner. It is submitted that at the earlier place where

the petitioner was residing, there were complaints against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the complaint of the petitioner, as stated in the writ petition, was enquired and parties were summoned. Police is also keeping a vigil on the area and appropriate actions have already been taken.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner's children were threatened by the police authorities which fact is refuted by learned Government Pleader and submits that no such event took place.

5. Considering the facts of the present case we do not find it as a fit case to issue any direction. We only observe that police shall keep vigil over the area in question and when a report is received, appropriate action shall be taken.

With the above observation, the Writ Petition is closed.
