J U D G M E N T

The limited prayer of the petitioners in the writ petition is for a direction to the 2nd respondent before whom the petitioners preferred Ext.P1 application under Section 28A of the Land Acquisition Act to consider and pass orders on the same expeditiously after hearing the petitioner.
