J U D G M E N T

SHAFFIQUE, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking police protection inter alia contending that there was a civil dispute between the petitioner and respondents 4 and 5 and in that process, a murder occurred and the petitioner was convicted in the said murder case. He is released from prison and now he apprehends threat from respondents 4 and 5.

2. Having regard to the facts of the case and the nature of submission made, we do not think that a direction as sought for in the writ petition can be granted. We only observe that, if there is any offence committed or attempt to commit offence, on the complaint of the petitioner, the police shall look into the matter.

Accordingly, this writ petition is closed.
