J U D G M E N T

The petitioners are Professors who have been continuing so from 27.07.1998. They have to be considered for promotion to the post of Professor (Higher Grade) as indicated at Ext.P3, after completion of ten years service. The petitioners, admittedly, completed ten years service long back. The petitioners are also retiring by 31.03.2016.

2. The learned Standing Counsel, based on the statement filed, submits that the University would require at least 1½ months time to finalise the proceedings.

3. In such circumstance, the proceedings shall be completed within six weeks from today and the petitioners granted benefits also within a reasonable time from that date.

The Writ Petition is disposed of in limine without any observation on merits, which shall be decided by the 2nd respondent.
