J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is a driver working in Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) at Kalpetta Depot. He was regularised, as driver in KSRTC with effect from 22.12.2011, consequent to memorandum No. PL 12/025739/2008 dated 10.06.2015. The grievance of the petitioner is that though, he was regularised in the year 2011, his regular salary from 22.12.2011 to 10.06.2015 was not sanctioned and disbursed. Even though, he has filed Ext.P3 representation, seeking an order directing to disburse the salary, no action has been taken so far.
