Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader.

2. By this writ petition the petitioner has come up seeking police protection against the 1st respondent. Petitioner's case is that her mother in law has died and her husband is coming from abroad. Petitioner apprehends obstruction and some offences at the hands of 1st respondent, who is her husband's brother.
