JUDGMENT

The petitioner Society has a grievance that despite its repeated representations, the authorities have so far not permitted it to open a branch within its area of operation.

2. In response to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Pleader has submitted that the authorities are willing to consider and dispose of petitioner's representation within four weeks.

In the facts and circumstances, having regard to the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader, this Court, without adverting to the merits of the matter, disposes of the writ petition with a direction to the first respondent to consider the representations of the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment. No order as to costs.
