The petitioner is a permit holder on the route Elamkadu Top - Pampavally - Vyttila Hub. The said permit is covered by stage carriage bearing registration No.KL-34/C-2043. He submitted a variation application and though the said application was placed before the R.T.A., it was adjourned stating that the basic permit has expired on 11.04.2015 and it was directed that the application for variation be boarded along with the application for renewal. Petitioner was also directed to submit a proposal for timings as well as a list of stops, by Ext.P1. In compliance with the direction in Ext.P1, the petitioner has submitted Exts.P2 and P3.
