JUDGMENT

Petitioner who is faced with revenue recovery proceedings for recovery of defaulted chitty amounts, seeks only a direction to the 6th respondent before whom Ext.P8 appeal has been filed, in terms of the revenue recovery Act, to consider and pass orders on the same, expeditiously after hearing the petitioner.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned standing counsel for the respondents.

3. On a consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case as also the submissions made across the Bar, I direct the 6th respondent to consider and pass orders on Ext.P8 appeal, within a period of one month, after hearing the petitioner. Recovery steps for recovery of amounts due from the petitioner shall be kept in abeyance, till such time as orders are passed by the 6th respondent as directed and communicated to the petitioner.

The writ petition is disposed as above.
