It appears that KIRTHADS had conducted an enquiry and submitted a report before the scrutiny committee. In the report it is stated that petitioner belongs to Ezhava community.

In that view of the matter, this Court is of the view, if the petitioner approaches the scrutiny committee, after verifying the report of KIRTHADS, the scrutiny committee shall take appropriate decision within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation from the petitioner.
