JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Government Pleader. No notice is being issued to respondent Nos. 5 and 6 in view of the order which is being passed.

2. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking police protection to the life and limb of the petitioners and their family members from respondents 5 and 6. Petitioners' case is that 2nd petitioner and her husband were attacked by respondents 5 and 6 with regard to which a complaint has already been submitted and police protection is sought for.

3. Learned Government Pleader after obtaining instructions submits that a crime has already been registered against respondents 5 and 6 and police is carrying on the investigation. It is further submitted that police is keeping a vigil on respondents 5 and 6.

In view of the aforesaid, we close the writ petition observing that the police authorities shall keep a vigil on respondents 5 and 6 and it shall be open for the petitioner to submit a complaint if any offence is committed or attempted to commit offence.
