JUDGMENT

A.M. SHAFFIQUE, J.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners alleging harassment by the police. It is stated that they are unnecessarily being summoned at the instance of the fourth respondent.

2. Learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the fourth respondent, the parties were summoned for the purpose of enquiry. The complaint had been closed on 20.10.2015. Thereafter, petitioners were not asked to appear before the police.

3. The above submission is recorded. We are of the opinion that summoning of the petitioners for enquiry on a complaint does not amounts to police harassment.

Hence the writ petition is dismissed.
