JUDGMENT

The petitioner's application under Clause 6 of the Kerala Land Utilization Order has been allowed by Ext.P3 by the District Collector, Ernakulam. Thereafter, the petitioner approached the Tahsildar by Ext.P4 to re-assess the land under Section 6A of the Kerala Land Tax Act, 1961.

This Court is of the view that in the light of the judgment of this Court in W.A.No.1294/2013 dated 8.4.2015, which is produced as Ext.P4, the petitioner's land shall be reassessed under Section 6A of the Kerala Land Tax Act within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
