JUDGMENT

The petitioner was granted OTS facility to settle the liability with the respondents. The petitioner could not honour the entire conditions in the OTS facility. The petitioner submits that he is prepared to comply with the OTS facility, if some more time is given to him. The petitioner submitted Ext.P3 representation for the revival of the OTS conditions.

2. This Court is of the view that Ext.P3 shall be considered by the 2nd respondent–The Managing Director of the KSIDC, within one month, after hearing the petitioner. If the petitioner deposits Rs.25 lakhs within two weeks, coercive steps against the petitioner shall be deferred.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
