JUDGMENT

K.Vinod Chandran, J.

The alleged detainee, who is 27 years of age, has been produced before this Court by the 4th respondent. The alleged detainee though admits the marriage with the petitioner, submits before this Court that she has already filed a divorce petition and she is not in the illegal custody of her parents. On a query by the Court, the alleged detainee unequivocally submits that she is not interested to talk to the petitioner and she intends to go with her mother, who has accompanied her.

In the above circumstances, the habeas corpus petition would stand closed.
