Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a marriage between the petitioner and the alleged detainee Ms.Ranjitha, daughter of the third respondent, was solemnized as per Religious Rights and Ceremonies on 24.06.2015, in a temple at Manakkapady, Karumalloor and the alleged detainee Ms.Ranjitha is now staying along with the petitioner. The learned Government Pleader had produced a statement recorded from the alleged detainee to the effect of reiterating the marriage, which had taken place on 24.06.2015. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is taking immediate steps to register the marriage under the Kerala Registration of Marriages (Common) Rules, without any further delay.
