ORDER

3. The alleged detenu Ramesh, aged about 21 years, son of Rajendran-the petitioner herein, appeared before this Court. The petitioner is also present before this Court.

4. It is alleged by the learned Counsel for the petitioner that Ramesh was illegally detained by the 4th respondent. However, the same was denied by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

5. Having recorded the same, since the detenu voluntarily appeared before this Court, recording his statement, the Habeas Corpus Petition is ordered to be closed.
