4. Under such circumstances, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to give fresh complaint to the concerned Station House Officer with the photographs which has

been enclosed before this Court and on such complaint being given, the respondent police is directed to conduct enquiry and proceed further as per the law laid down by the Honourable Apex Court in Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)].
