3. The allegation of the petitioner is that a forged patta has been created for her property. The allegation is very serious in nature. It appears that the the petitioner has given a complaint to the respondent police through post. In the facts of this case, this Court directs the petitioner to go in person and give a fresh complaint to the respondent police and on receipt of the same, the respondent police shall enquire into the complaint and take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Honourable Apex Court in Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)].

4. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.

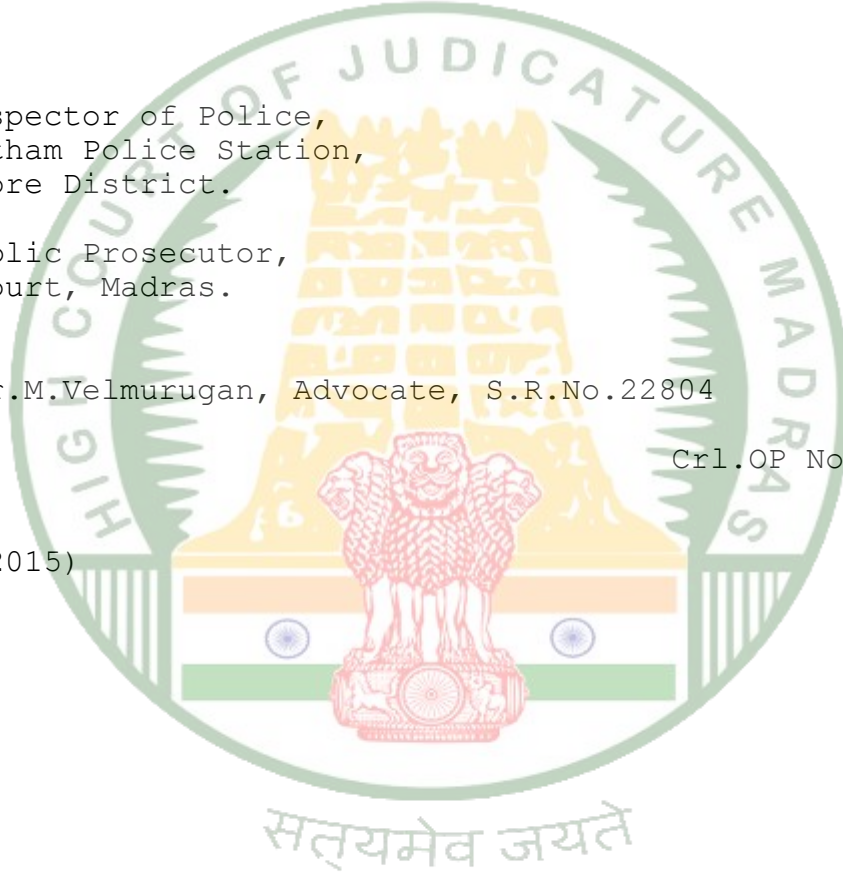
