The respondent police shall refer the matter to the Social Welfare Department for enquiry and take action in accordance with law as per the law laid down by the Honourable Apex Court in Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)].

4. With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is closed.

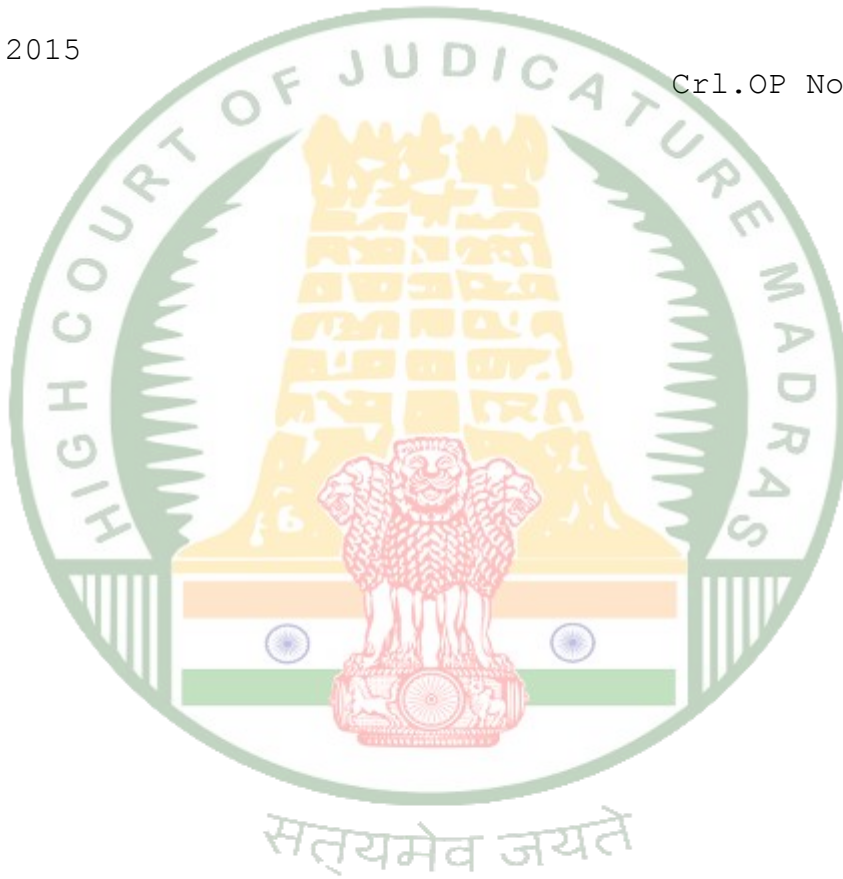
