The petitioner, who is the wife of the detenu Sethupathy, son of Settu, aged about 23 years, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the first respondent dated 14.07.2015 against her husband branding him as a "Bootlegger" under Section 2(b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the order of detention passed by the first respondent as against the husband of the petitioner dated 14.07.2015 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. Rt No.5592, Home, Prohibition & Excise (IX) Department, dated 01.09.2015 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
