Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, would submit that the respondent police have received some clues about the whereabouts of the petitioner's son.

3 In these circumstances, this petition is closed, with a direction to the respondent police to pursue the investigation in Cr.No.2518/2015 and keep the petitioner informed.
