At the same time, the petitioner

should submit himself to the first respondent for interrogation and enquiry, if he receives any summons.

With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

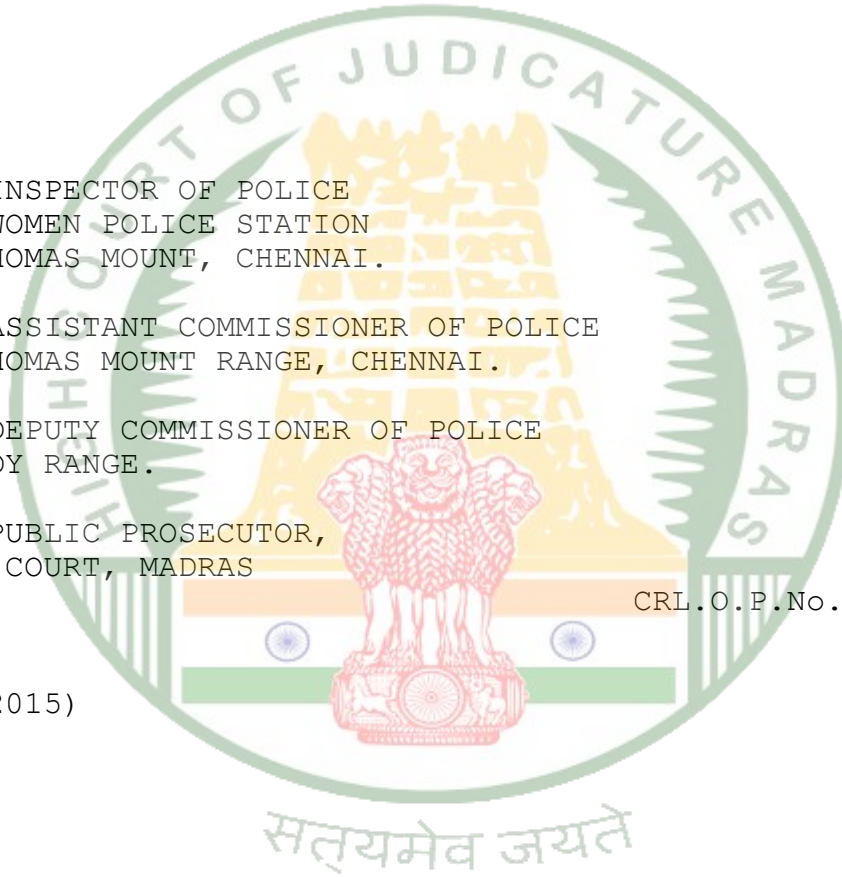
