Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents.

2.This petition has been filed by the petitioner/husband of the detainee Anitha, W/o.Bharathi Raja, aged 22 years, directing the respondents to cause production of his wife/the detainee before this Court and to set her at liberty.

3.The detenue Anitha is secured and produced before this Court by the respondent police. On enquiry, the detenue told us that there is no illegal detention of her by anybody and that she is residing with her paternal aunt.

4.Recording the statement made by the detenue to the effect that there is no illegal detention, we are of the view that this petition could be closed as nothing further remains to be considered in this petition.

5.Accordingly, this petition is closed. It is open to the petitioner to approach the appropriate forum seeking remedy, according to law.
