respondent police, they will issue summon to her and as otherwise,
they will not cause any inconvenience to her.

the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police
for interrogation and enquiry, if she receives any summon. At the
same time, the petitioner shall not be harassed under the guise of
investigation.

With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

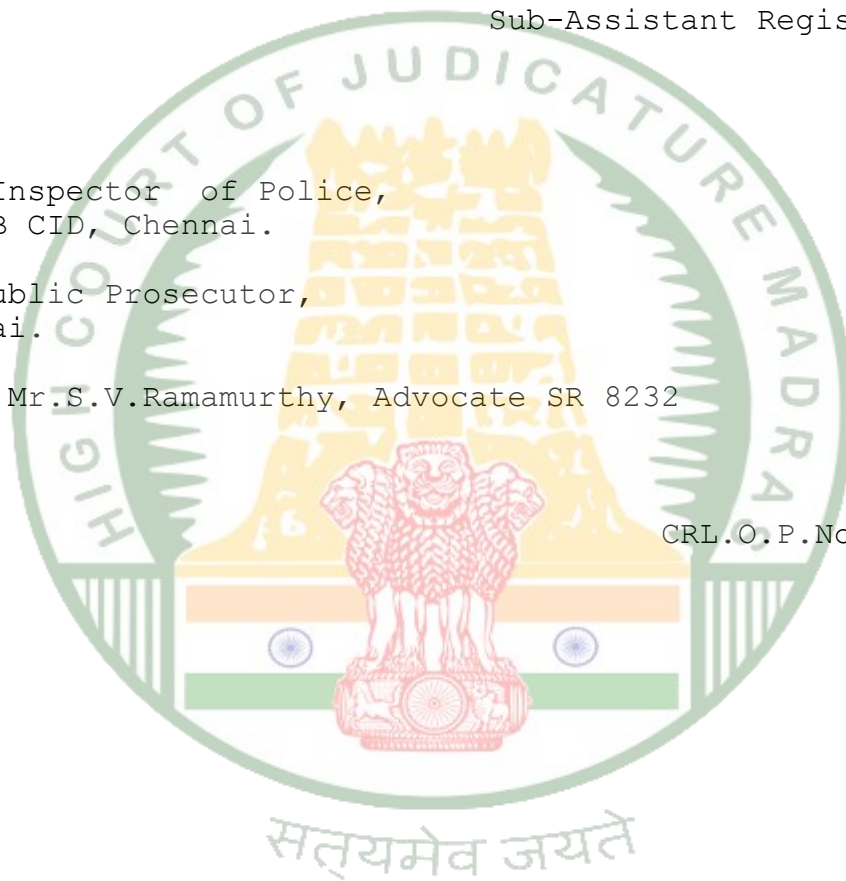
