2.The petitioner would admit that 75% of the amount payable as per original quantum fixed, has been paid to the petitioner, namely Rs.3,75,000/-. According to the petitioner, offence was committed in April 2014 and the amendment having come into force on February 2014, she is entitled to the additional benefit of Rs.1,87,500/-.

3.In the light of the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the 1st respondent to consider the representation of the

petitioner on merits and in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. No costs.
