The petitioner, who is wife of the detenu herein, viz., Narayanan, son of Ramanathan, aged about 52 years has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 21.01.2015 against her husband branding him as a "Black Marketeer" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act 1980 [Act 7 of 1980].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the husband of the petitioner herein dated 21.01.2015 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. [Rt] No.107, Cooperation, Food and Consumer Protection [E3] Department dated 13.03.2015 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
