Habeas Corpus Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus to call for the records relating to the petitioner's husband detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order, dated 28.01.2015 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings No.41/2015 and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents herein to produce the said petitioner's husband namely Suresh, Son of Dhamodaran, aged 23 years before this Court and set the petitioner's husband at liberty from detention, now the petitioner's husband detained at Central Prison-II, Puzhal, Chennai-600 066.

The petitioner, who is the wife of the detenu Suresh, male, aged 23 years, son of Dhamodaran, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order in No.41/2015 dated 28.01.2015 passed by the second respondent against her husband branding him as a "Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the husband of the petitioner dated 28.01.2015 has been revoked by the Government in G.O. [Rt] No.1883, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XIII] Department dated 13.03.2015 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
